Welcome Back !

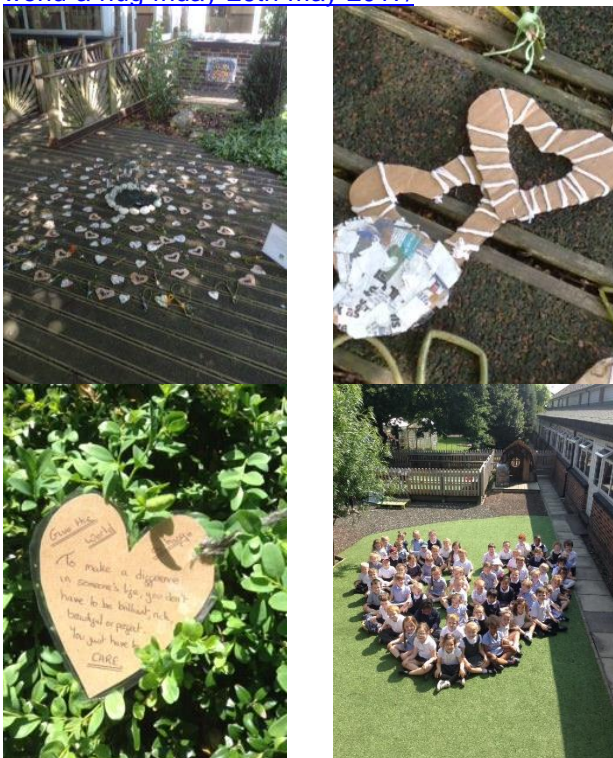
Welcome back to the last half term of the year! This is always a busy one, so please check all the dates carefully as there is a lot happening.

Users of Social media need to be aware that:

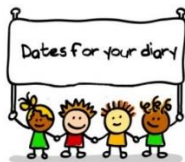
- All posts are not private and are considered within the public domain.
