Please note children in FS, Y1, Y2 & Y3 will not be allowed to walk home alone they **must** be collected.

We strongly advise that all children are collected from clubs.

For all clubs please complete the slip opposite and return it to main reception along with payment in full. If you are allocated a place in a club you will get a slip confirming the details – if you are not successful all monies will be returned.
