We are pleased to announce that school was successful in gaining a CIF Bid worth over £400,000 from the DfE Academy Funding. This means that over summer we will be having a new roof and a new central heating system fitted in school. In addition to this we have also been successful in gaining a Safeguarding Grant to fund a new reception entrance and secure electronic fobbed doors throughout school, this work has already commenced and will be completed during the summer term.
